As a local resident I would like to object to the plans to develop the former Boronia Heights Secondary College into high density housing.

This is because the area is significant for:

1. Its magnificent canopy trees
2. Plants of rare and threatened species status within the City of Knox
3. The large number of birds that reside at this site
4. The important wildlife population
5. The important wildlife link and corridor it provides between the nearby National Park and the surrounding suburbs of Knox.
6. The large amount of public open space and the opportunity for recreational activity by residents.

**This significant area should be retained as Public Open Space.**

The recent petition of over 2,000 signatures submitted to State Parliament reinforces this view amongst Knox residents.

All other former school sites in The City of Knox have gone to developers - what about this one going to the people.

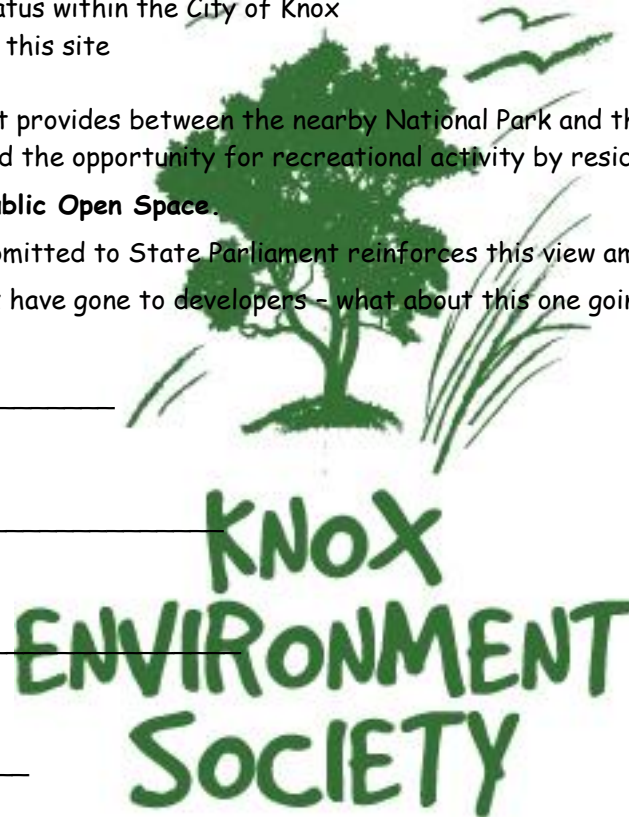
